Job Summary

The Network Operations Manager will provide for deployment and on-going support for routers/WAN extending to 400 sites across the country. This position is in support of major workstation and WAN deployment effort and will run the length of the project, approximately 5-6 months

Essential Duties and Tasks

- Prepare CISCO 861w routers for remote deployment, including IOS setup and shipping
- Assist remote technical staff with installation troubleshooting which includes interoperability between the routers, ISP modem devices and PCs at remote sites
- Possibility of occasional site visit to assist regular field staff
- Other duties as assigned

Skills, Knowledge and Experience

- Technical experience with Cisco router and/or firewall setup, configuration and troubleshooting
- Advanced understanding of TCP/IP and relevant protocols, routing and routed protocols as well as good understanding of packet level diagnosis
- Experience with Cisco IOS based VPN hardware clients and servers
- Experience with configuring and troubleshooting site to site VPNs
- Experience with Cisco Network Configuration Manager is a plus
- Experience with supporting various types of broadband circuits
- Experience with PC operating systems, and networking
- Experience WAN environments

Physical Demands

- Must be able to pass pre-employment drug screen, and will be subject to any post-accident and/or reasonable suspicion testing throughout employment
